III. Submission of credentials and identification papers

With a view to ensuring a smooth verification process, the Members of the Regional Commission are kindly requested to submit their credentials electronically to the Secretariat no later than ten days before the opening of the session (31st January 2026).

The originals must be submitted at least one day before the opening of the Commission session.

Only credentials from Heads of State or Prime Ministers, Ministers of Foreign Affairs or Ministers responsible for tourism of the respective State or his/her equivalent will be regarded as valid credentials. Only formal letters or faxes bearing the signature of the competent authority are considered valid. (See model credentials letter in the Annex.)

Only duly accredited delegates shall be authorized to exercise the right to vote and to take the floor at the meeting of the Regional Commission.

IV. Status of Participation and Reception

1. The Government of the State of Kuwait will take the necessary measures to facilitate the arrival, stay and departure of the participants invited by the Organization. Throughout their stay, participants invited by the Organization will benefit from the privileges and immunities provided for in the Agreement concluded between the Organization and the Ministry of Information and Culture.
2. The Kuwaiti Authorities will organize the reception of participants at **Kuwait International Airport** and will facilitate the free transfer of delegates on arrival and on departure between the airport, the selected hotels and the venue of the meetings.

VI. Entry Formalities

7. Delegates are requested to contact diplomatic or consular missions of the State of Kuwait in their countries to obtain an entry visa.

The entry visa will be issued upon arrival after submitting an official letter with the details of the participating delegation, however, participants are strongly advised to submit a copy of passports, a personal photo with a white background and a notification of the date of arrival in the State of Kuwait, and send the required documents to the following email : 52CME@media.gov.kw– the Ministry of Information and Culture) no later than the deadline of January 20th, 2026.

VII. Registration and Badges

12. **Local Currency and exchange rates:** The local currency is the Kuwaiti Dinar. The applicable exchange rate in January 2026 is approximately 1 Kuwaiti Dinar for 2.77 Euros and 1 Kuwaiti Dinar for 3.25 USD.
13. **Weather:** Kuwait enjoys sunny days in February. The average maximum temperature is 20°C and the average low is 11°C.

- 14. Official language:** The official language of the State of Kuwait is Arabic. English is also widely spoken especially in hotels and banks.
- 15. Kuwait Time Zone:** The official time in Kuwait is GMT +3 hours
- 16. Electricity:** The electrical sockets (outlets) in Kuwait usually supply electricity at 240 volts AC (UK three pin socket).
